

General Commentary:

• Reading and Understanding

A number of candidates mis-read the question and as such chose the incorrect answer. Candidates lost easy marks by not reading the question carefully. If in doubt, candidates can use the 'flag' function in TestReach to select a question that they wish to come back to and check they have read what the question is asking, or re-check the answer they have chosen.

• <u>Time Management</u>

Candidates should plan their time well so they do not rush through the exam and make mistakes in their answer choices. Candidates are reminded that they should go back through their answers once finished, to check they are happy with their choice.
