## REVIEW FROM THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF EXAMINERS

## **OVERVIEW**

In 2022 a significant step change was achieved in the IBD examination candidate journey, both through the introduction of new members to IBD Examination Board team and its partnering with a new assessment platform supplier (TestReach). This all resulted in every IBD examination in 2022 being taken online.

In 2022 almost 3000 candidates in over 90 different countries, sat at least one of IBD's examinations ranging from Foundation level all the way up to Master Brewer and Master Distiller level.

I am pleased to announce that after the IBD 2022 examinations sessions, there are now a further 7 new IBD Master Brewers and 2 new IBD Master Distillers, as well as 99 Qualified IBD Diploma Brewers, 38 Qualified IBD Diploma Distillers and 21 Qualified IBD Diploma Packagers.

In addition to this 153 candidates in total successfully passed the IBD Foundation level examinations and 809 passed the General Certificate Examinations.

Our warmest congratulations to all candidates who passed.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Natalie Jewitt and Chloe Falodun for their hard work, dedication and support in the delivery of the 2022 examination cycles, their contribution to the delivery of the IBD Examinations is, and continues to be exemplary.

I would also like to thank every single one of the Examiners for their amazing contribution and dedication to the IBD Examination Board. It is a privilege and honour to have their support across the respective elements of the examination cycles. Special thanks goes to George Blair and Mike Partridge for their service and recognition as they have both retired as examiners after the 2022 examinations and also to David Cook who resigned from the IBD Examination Board to join the IBD Board of Trustees

- "Do not forget the importance of recipes, specifications, procedures and and/or standards (standard operating procedures) for control of processes"
- "Keep up to date with fermentation and beer processing knowledge as well as distillation with the IBD Brewer and Distiller International magazine"
- "Please answer the number of long answer questions required"

#### **Master Examinations**

 "Answers which combined know-how with evidence of practical experience achieved the best marks"

- "When answering a trouble-shooting type question, both the methodology (how) and the actions to be taken (what) need to be covered"
- "When asked 'state all assumptions', please do so. These provide the foundation for an answer and enable particular circumstances/processes/plant that candidates are familiar with can be taken into account"
- "candidates would benefit from spending more time studying and understanding the financial and broader business aspects of the masters syllabi as to be successful in today's brewing and distilling businesses, good financial and business understanding is key. This aspect of candidates answer papers is often answered poorly or avoided"
